

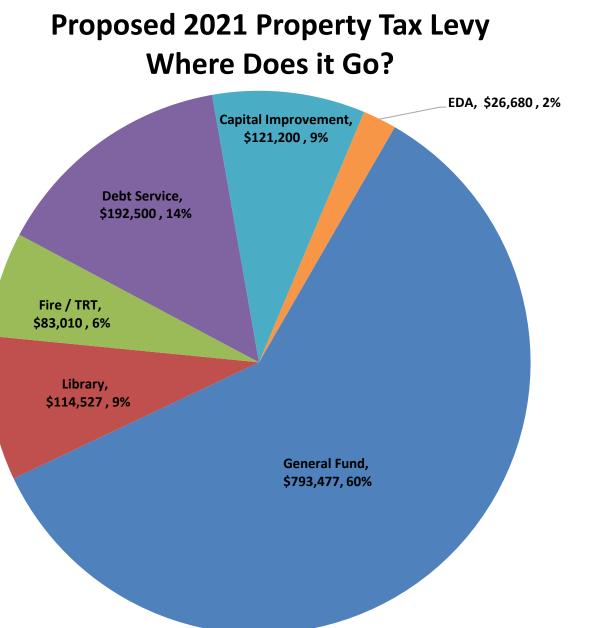

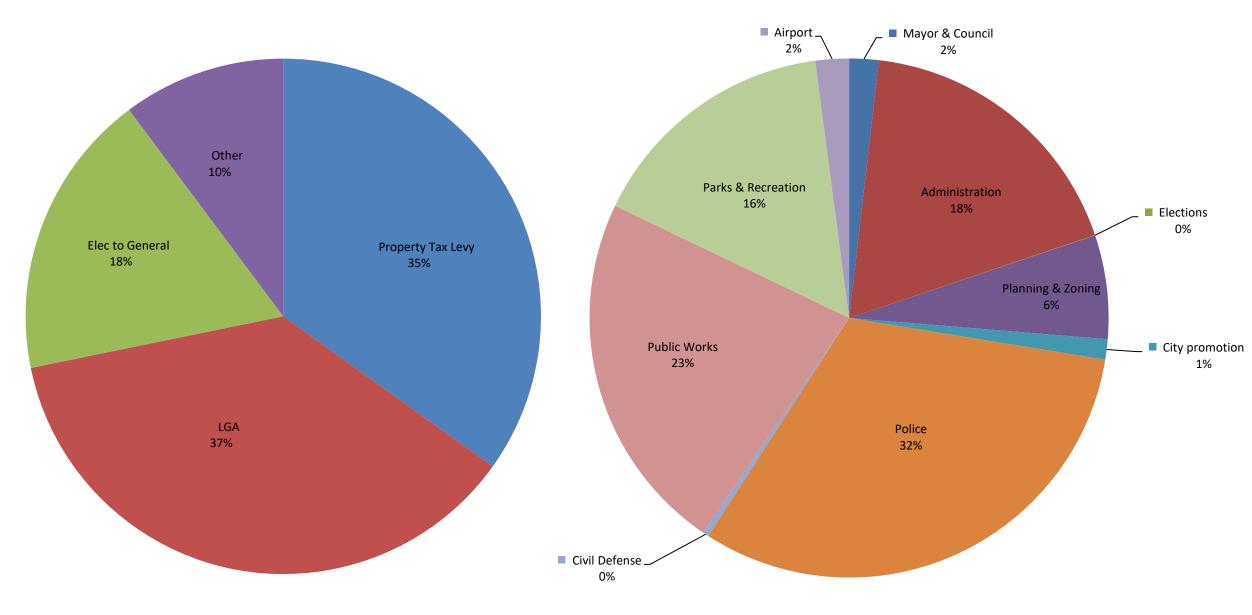

  - 2020 (Pay 2021) EMV = \$144,215,600

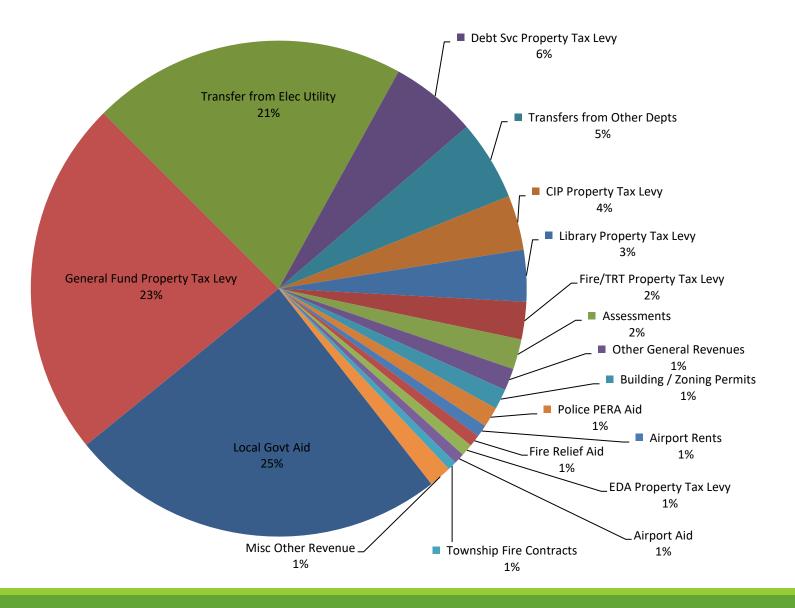

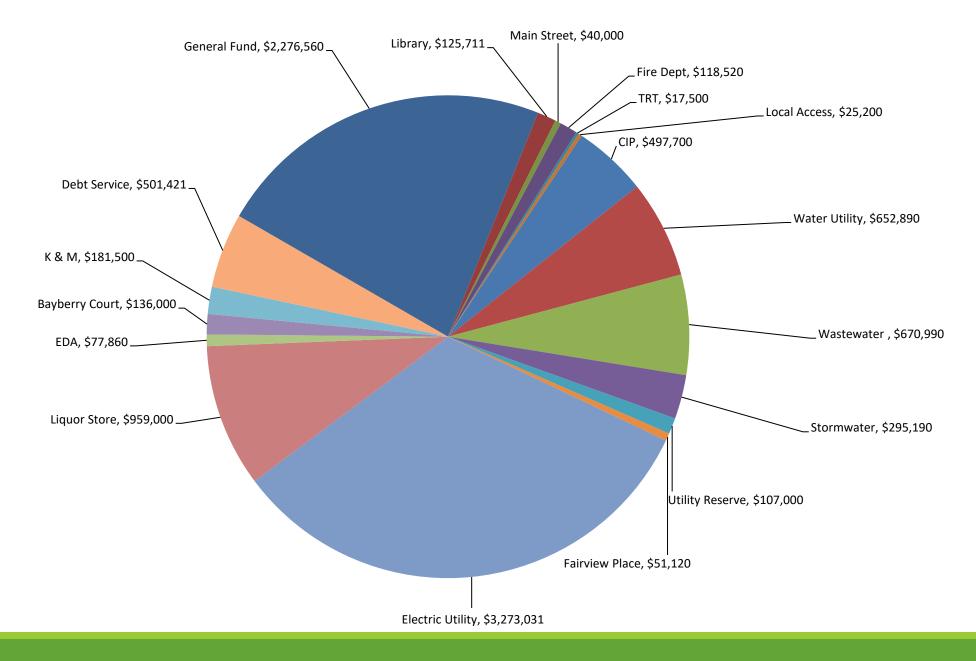

#### **Proposed 2021 Budget - Total Revenues for Levy Impacted Funds**

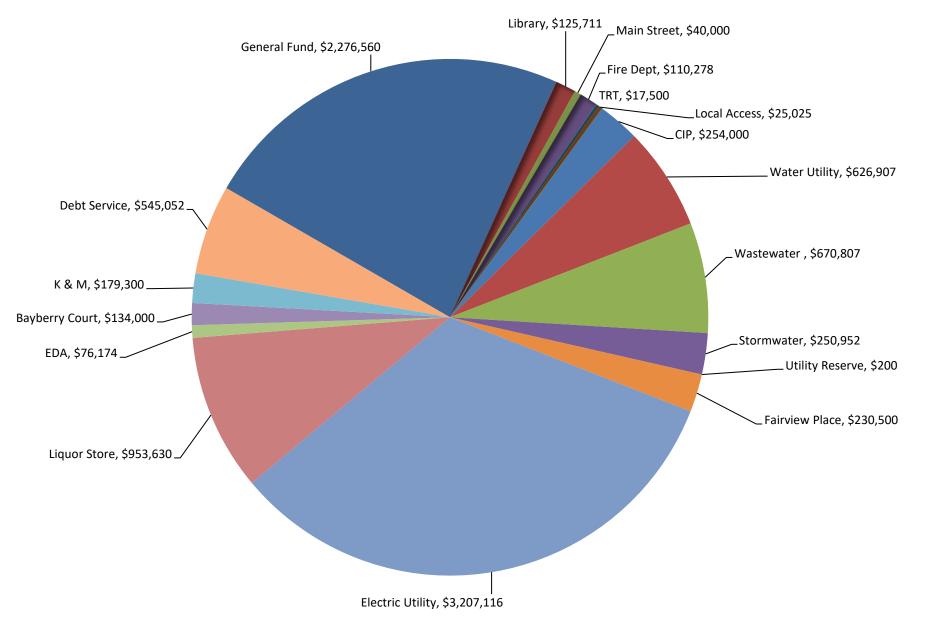
**Property Tax** Levy makes up 39.15% of total revenues in levy supported funds



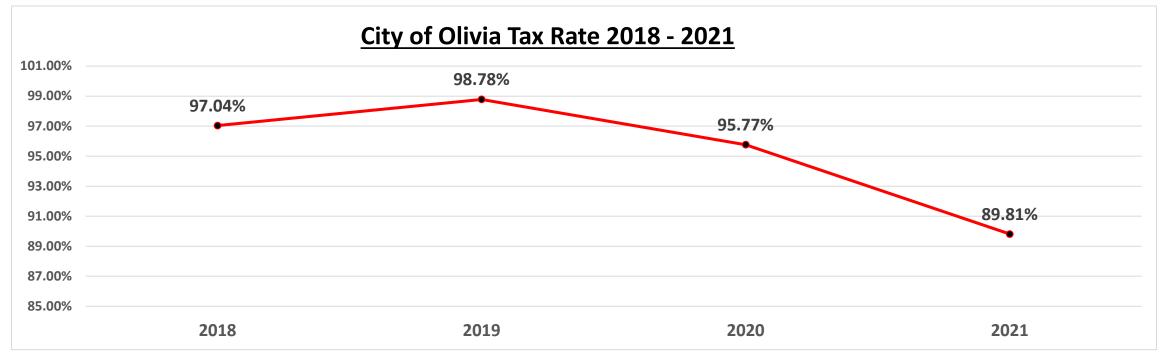
#### **Total Revenues for 2021 Budget**
